

Oakfield Primary School - Smoke Free Policy

Purpose

This policy has been developed to protect all employees, service users, customers and visitors from exposure to second-hand smoke and to assist compliance with the Health Act 2006.

Policy

It is the policy of Oakfield Primary School that all our workplaces are smoke free, and all employees have a right to work in a smoke free environment. Smoking is prohibited on the school site.

Aims

- To promote a healthy life style
- To maintain the school and grounds as a totally smoke free zone

Practice

- Smoking is not allowed anywhere on the school site at any time
- The policy applies to all temporary or permanent staff including supply teachers
- The policy applies to all visitors to the school including parents, students, suppliers, builders and repair people
- Appropriate no smoking signs are clearly displayed at all entrances to the school.
