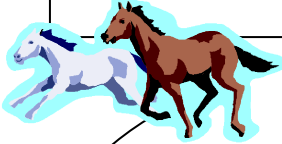


## WOW FACTORS:

Visit from a real Vet nurse.



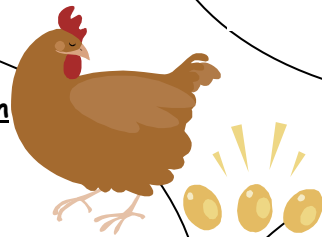
### Mathematics

- Learning to add and subtract animals on the farm.



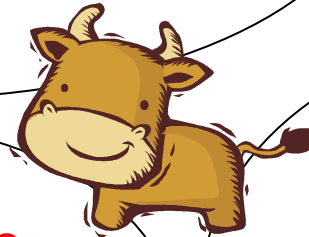
### Expressive Arts and Design
